Script:

Receptionist: Hello. Do you have an appointment today?

Edna: Hi. Yes, I do. I have an appointment with Doctor Lee.

Receptionist: Doctor Lee. Okay. Are you Edna?

Edna: Yes.

Receptionist: Okay great. Edna, do you have your care card with you today?

Edna: Yup.

Receptionist: Good.

All right. Great. Thank you. You can sit over there. The doctor will be with you in a minute.

Edna: Okay. Thank you.

Doctor Lee: Hi Edna.

Edna: Hi.

Doctor Lee: How are you?

Edna: I'm okay. Thank you.
