**got hired:**

  - got the job
  - filled out an application form
- I have a master's degree in **landscape** architecture.

**landscape:**

  - the design of a building
  - the trees and plants, the shape of land
- My previous employers were my references.

**previous employers:**

  - new bosses
  - old bosses
- I was trying to **gain experience** with plants and flowers.

**gain experience:**

  - get experience
  - show my experience
- I work in a landscape architecture **firm**.

**firm:**

  - a farm or garden
  - a business or company
