CLB 4 – Voting in Canada

One of the privileges of Canadian citizenship is the right to vote. You can vote in a federal election if you are:

- •a Canadian citizen; and
- at least 18 years old on voting day; and
- on the voters' list.







Review Question:

To be eligible to vote, you must

- be living in Canada, an adult, and have ID.
- be a Canadian citizen, have a job, and pay taxes.
- have a job, own a house or apartment, and be living in Canada
- be a Canadian citizen, 18 years old or older, and on the voters' list.
